Combining a range of materials with spatial precision, the Linea Studio team produces environments that convey emotional and visual harmony.

While a Cesar kitchen is undoubtedly beautiful, the look is far from the only motivation behind the brand's products. "At Linea Studio, **one factor we never overlook is how cabinet choice will affect the users' health and the environment,**" Naranjo says. "This dedication to making eco-friendly choices is mirrored in Cesar's materials, which are **sourced from responsibly managed forests.**" The finished product is also **CARB2 compliant**, so Cesar's cabinetry will not emit any volatile compounds that could pose a danger to those in close proximity.
